Targa Road Rally Championship Updated 27/7/2026

Best 4 Targas to count from 7, including a Marshal score

Points will be class based and awarded to drivers and navigators as follows:

5 points for starting an event (code S in table)

15 points for the highest placed championship contender in class

12 points for the 2nd highest placed championship contender in class

10 points for the 3rd highest placed championship

9 points for the 4th highest placed championship contender

down to 1 point for 12th highest placed and lower championship contender

In addition all contenders will receive 0.2 bonus points per competitor beaten in the Class, whether these are registered contenders or not, up to a maximum of one point

Points are scored on a crew basis

Contenders can claim 15 points for Organising or Marshalling on one event (code M in table).

No driver or navigator may win more than one award, except the 'Under 25' and Novice Single Venue Challenge awards

The Inter Club event MUST be entered in order to score points. Inter Club Licences are required for both crew members to enter the Inter Club event

Bonus points are awarded for all Competitors beaten in Class, including Retirements.

Points are scored in the Class entered on an Event, but included in the Championship Class stated at the start of the year. Recalculating the Event Classes in to the Classes declared at the start of the year is impractical. Using the Event Classes recognises progression during the year.

Best 2 of 3 events to count for Single Venue Novice Challenge

If only 10 or 9 events run then the best 5 scores will count, If only 8 or 7 events run then the best 4 scores will count,

If only 6 or 5 events run then best 3 scores will count, 4 events run, then the best 2 scores will count.

If there are less than four rounds held, the championship will be cancelled.
